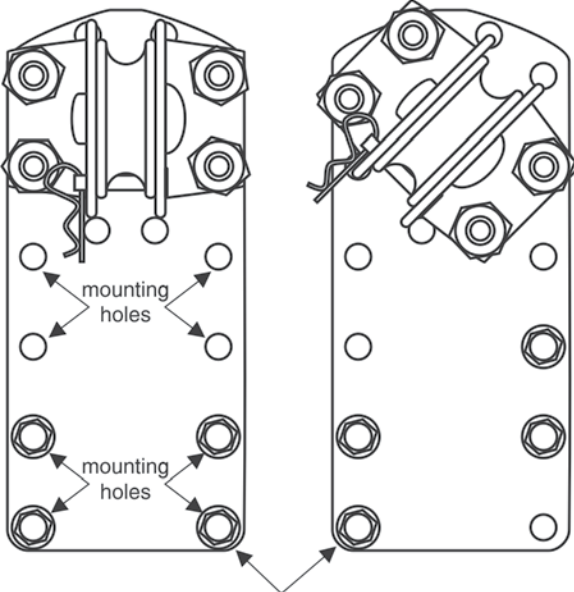

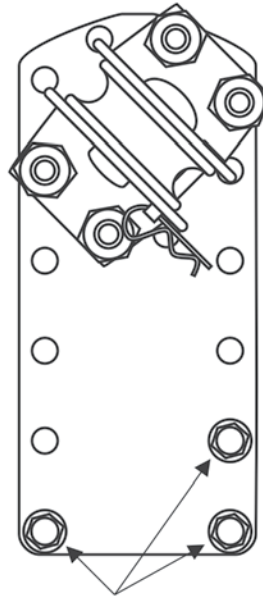

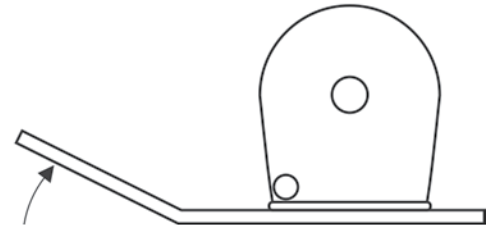
The pulley can be rotated in three different ways.



Use any of the eight mounting holes for the four self-tapping screws, based on the application.



A minimum of three self-tapping screws must be used.



The bracket can be bent to fit around obstructions.

Parts list

- (1) pulley mounting bracket
- (4) machined screws with nuts
- (4) self-tapping screws

Product description: the bracket is intended to facilitate installation of the InvisiBrake pulley in those vehicles without a pulley mounting location due to recesses or obstructions in the firewall.

Installation instructions

1. Position the pulley and bracket under the brake pedal arm so that the pulley will be directly in line with the cable.
 - The pulley can be rotated on the bracket in one of three ways, as shown above.
 - Choose a mounting location for the bracket that will allow you to attach it with at least three of the four self-tapping screws, as shown above.

• If necessary, any part of the bracket can be bent, as shown above.

2. Attach the pulley to the bracket with the four machined screws and nuts, with the nuts at the top of the bracket.
3. Attach the bracket with the self-tapping screws.
