Required tools

torque wrench

flat nut washer

• ¾" socket wrench

Attach the adaptor

1. Use three sets of the included nuts, bolts, lock washers and flat washers to attach the adaptor to the spare

tire carrier, as shown in Figure 1.

Torque the three bolts to 57 ft./lbs.

Attach the spare tire

1. Follow the spare tire carrier instructions to lower the carrier, and roll the spare tire up to it. (The latest version of the instructions is at roadmasterinc.com, under 'Support.'

Position the wheel so that a lug hole is at the top, aligned to the upper and lower holes (Figure 1).

2. If the wheel has a smaller bolt circle (see the 'Fit Chart' above), insert a bolt and flat washer through the lower hole in the adaptor and through the spare; use the continued on next page

continued from preceding page upper hole for wheels with a larger bolt circle.

Swing the carrier up and allow it to lock. The lug hole directly opposite the bolt will line up in one of the two adjusting slots.


Attach the second bolt and flat washer through the wheel and the adjusting slot.

3. As shown in Figure 1, fasten the two sets of plastic washers, flat washers, lock washers and nuts on the other side of the wheel to the bolts and flat washers. Use the 3/4" socket wrench to tighten the two bolts.

CAUTION

Position the plastic washers directly against the wheel of the spare tire. Otherwise, non-warranty damage to the surface of the wheel may occur.
