

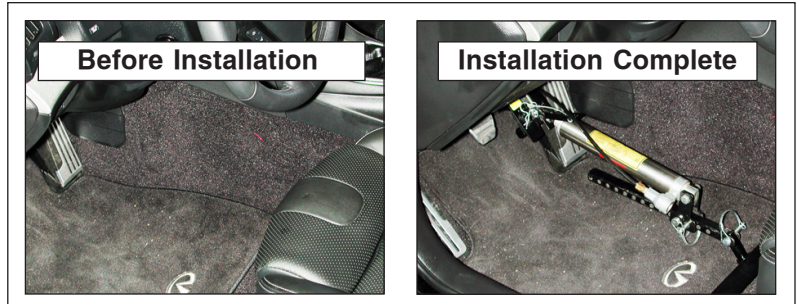
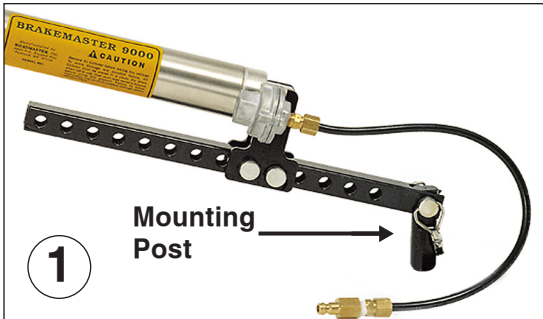
SEAT ADAPTER KIT #88267 INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Instructions

1. Locate the mounting post (Fig.1) that came with your BrakeMaster. If needed, order part number 450596. Now, secure the post to the center of the seat adapter using the included 3/8" x 3/4" bolt and 3/8" lock washer. If the hole is countersunk, use the Allen head bolt and lock washer included with this kit.
2. Remove the two front seat track covers. Remove the two 14mm (head) front seat track bolts. Now, remove the two rear seat track covers and loosen the two 14mm (head) rear seat track bolts (Fig.2).
3. Place the seat adapter over the seat track mount on the passenger side and under the driver's side mount (Fig.3). Place a 10mm lock washer and fender washer over the supplied 10mm x 1.25 x 35mm bolt, and bolt through the seat adapter and seat track on the driver's side (Fig.4).

Instructions

4. Place a 10mm lock washer and fender washer over the supplied 10mm x 1.25 x 45mm bolt, and place a 1" x 3/8" pipe spacer between the seat adapter and the seat track on the passenger side. Bolt through the seat adapter, pipe spacer and seat track (Fig.5). *Note:* the mounting post on the adapter (Fig.1) must be directly in line to the brake pedal (Fig.6). The BrakeMaster air cylinder may jam or function incorrectly if the mounting post is not directly in line with the brake pedal.

5. Attach the air cylinder to the adapter.
